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LOCAL RULES

1. OUT OF BOUNDS AND COURSE BOUNDARIES (Rule 18.2)

- a) Beyond all electric boundary fences.
- b) Beyond all white stakes.
- c) On or over estates roads when playing Hole # 2, 5, 7, 13 & 18
- d) All residential properties **and even** if property does not have a fence.

2. RELIEF FROM ELECTRIC BOUNDARY FENCE

Warning: The electric boundary fence carries high voltages.

If the player's ball lies on the course within one club-length of the electric boundary fence on holes 8 & 11, he or she may, without penalty, take relief under Rule 16.1, using as the reference point the point that is two club-lengths from the fence not nearer the hole.

3. PENALTY AREAS (Rule 17)

- All unmarked ditches are treated as Red Penalty Areas
- The riverbeds on Hole # 7, 15, 16 and 17 are treated as Red Penalty Areas and is identified by red stakes and/or lines.

4. ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS (Rule 16.1)

Damage by Animals: All areas affected by warthog damage in the General Area are treated as Ground Under Repair from which free relief is allowed under Rule 16.1b

Interference does not exist if Animal Holes only interferes with the player's stance.

5. INTEGRAL OBJECTS (Rule 16.1)

- a) All dirt roads

6. RULES ISSUES DURING ROUND (Rule 20.1)

If uncertain of the right procedure a player may complete the hole with balls under Rule 20.1c(3) to avoid unreasonable delay. If two balls are played, the matter MUST be reported to the Rules Committee/Professional Shop as soon as is practicable before he returns his scorecard. Penalty for failure to do so is DISQUALIFICATION.

7. PACE OF PLAY (Rule 5.6)

A round of golf is meant to be played at a prompt pace. The required time for players to complete 18 holes is **4hrs and 45 minutes** including halfway house. Players are required to play READY golf and to always keep up with the group in front of you.

8. SIREN SIGNALS AND WEATHER

Players are advised to vacate the course should any inclement weather occur. Do not continue play. Play should only continue once the weather has cleared completely.

9. DISTANCE MARKERS

All '100' and '150' distance markers and distances on sprinkler heads are measured in metres to the front of the green.

10. ENVIRONMENT

Please respect the wildlife as well as the fauna and flora on the golf course and rough areas. It is in the golfer's interest to keep the area as natural as possible for all to enjoy!

11. PLUS STROKES

+1 = Hole 17 +2 = Hole 7 +3 = Hole 16 +4 = Hole 5
+5 = Hole 14 +6 = Hole 8 +7 = Hole 13 +8 = Hole 2
